SUBJECT: NYVIP BROADBAND OPTION

We are pleased to announce that the NYVIP version 6 software, which was recently mailed to you for installation, adds a new option to transmit inspection data via broadband. Broadband internet connectivity eliminates the need and monthly cost of maintaining a dedicated phone line. Further, it reduces the time it takes to complete an inspection by providing faster communication between a NYVIP work station and DMV. It also provides quicker repairs via remote access should that be necessary.

You are not required to use a broadband connection, it is completely optional.

The broadband connection is an additional option to replace the current dial up function. Facilities can choose either communication method. No additional equipment is needed other than described above. The same Testcom charges for per inspection transmission still apply.
